### **WARHOL'S HOLLY WOODLAWN AT GANYMEDE'S FALL FESTIVAL** **Underground film star to perform at Church Street Theatre**

WASHINGTON -- Holly Woodlawn, one of the first bona fide transgendered performers of the Stonewall era, will grace Ganymede Arts' stage during its second annual Fall Arts Festival. The week-long carnival of theater, dance, instrumental, vocal and visual arts will take place Sept. 26 - Oct. 5 at Church Street Theatre with Woodlawn kicking off the celebration on opening night.

Woodlawn gained fame when she starred in Andy Warhol's underground films *Trash* with Joe Dallesandro and *Women in Revolt* with Candy Darling and Jackie Curtis. Along with other film and stage credits, she wrote a 1991 autobiography called *A Low Life in High Heels*. In recent years, Woodlawn has performed in sold-out cabaret shows in New York City and Los Angeles.

The incomparable actress will also take part in "Life Underground: A Warhol/Morrisey Film Event" on Sept. 27. The retrospective co-sponsored by One In Ten and Reel Affirmations will explore the roots of the "underground" film movement and its effects on modern cinema. Preceding the festival, 20 fans will enjoy a three-course meal with Woodlawn at Floriana's Restaurant. The Sept. 25 \$100-per plate dinner is hosted by Ganymede's board of directors.
